Music Notes

All You Need is Love

The final two characters not only reside in the New Testament, but they wrote most of it. John, the author of five NT books, mentions "love" in three of them. From the Gospel of John and the book of 1st John, he mentions "love" more emphatically than any other author in any other book. Again showing the diversity of love as a noun, he writes in John 15:13: "No one has greater love than this, that he lays down his life for his friends". He also mentions in it in 1st John 4:16, when he makes one of the most definitive statements of the Bible: "GOD is love". We all know how John speaks of God's love for us in John 3:16. And when Jesus speaks to his disciples at the last supper in John 13:34, He tells them to love one another just as He has loved them. What I would like to emphasize with John is 1st John 4:7: "Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God". John really tries to drive the point home that love and God are synonymous.

The final character who speaks of love wrote at least 13 books of the NT and perhaps 14. An entire chapter concerning that subject is found in 1st Corinthians 13. Paul also gave instructions to husbands, wives, and children on how each of them should love each other. The most profound statement about love is in 1st Corinthians 8:1, for in the latter half of the verse it says: "knowledge puffs up, but love builds up". Paul promotes a love of God over a love of knowledge, because in that day Corinth was where a person would go to be educated. Many people were losing sight of God for that reason, so Paul was trying to point them in the right direction.
